### 18.95 GIVEBACK UPDATE: RECAP OF THE SPRING QUARTER (APRIL-JUNE)

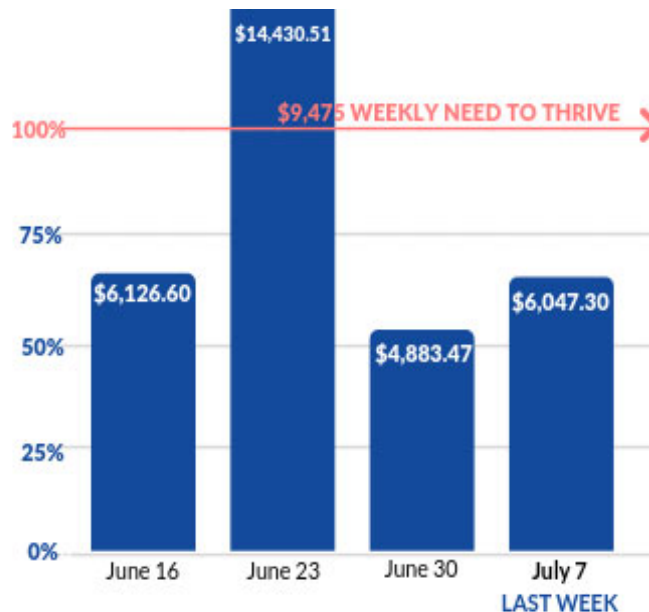
Beginning in April, we changed the way we calculate our giveback from a weekly to a quarterly surplus. That means that we needed to exceed \$123,175 (our weekly need of \$9475 multiplied by 13 weeks in the quarter) in order to provide for our charity partner, HOUR CHILDREN. We made this change to better reflect what we can afford to give back to our community while at the same time ensuring the parish needs are taken care of.

During the Spring Quarter, we collected a total of \$103,948.03 which got us to 84% of our goal. Not bad, but we can do better! We've decided work with HOUR CHILDREN again for the current Summer quarter. Please partner with us in mission and pray that we can give back to this great local organization helping incarcerated women and their families get back on their feet.
