FAMILY FAITH FORMATION NEWS

Joe Long will be working with us this year to help coordinate our Family Faith Formation. Some of you will remember Joe as he was present here last year assisting Jayne as we transitioned to another model for our program. The following is an introduction from Joe for those who haven't yet met him. A warm welcome to Joe as he walks with us in faith formation this year.

Joe Long is currently serving as the Director of Children's Faith Formation for the Archdiocese of New York. His work includes supporting faith formation leaders, assist parishes in developing faith formation programs from the time of baptism to grade 5.

He was raised in Philadelphia and served there as the Catholic School teacher and Director of Religious Education in two parishes there. Joe moved to North Carolina and served there in a parish as the Pastoral Associate for Evangelization, Formation and Liturgy and served there for 23 years. He moved to New York 8 years ago and worked in the area and was a Pastoral Associate in Diocese of Rockville Centre before his opportunity to serve in the Archdiocese.

Joe attended Allentown College of St. Francis de Sales (now De Sales University) and Villanova University with an emphasis on Religious Education. He looks forward to working with families so that we may Live Jesus now and forever.

ADULT FAITH FORMATION (RCIA)

The RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) is a process of initiation into the Catholic Community of Faith for persons who are experiencing a conversion in their lives and seeking either Christian baptism in the Catholic Church or full Communion with the Catholic tradition of Eucharist and Confirmation. It is a process which enables the study of the Gospels, Catholic Christian teaching, the acceptance of Christian values and morality, the development and deepening of a life of prayer and action with the support and involvement of the local Christian community.
