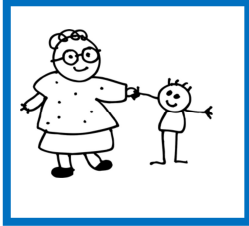

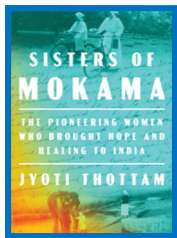
Upcoming events: Oct 23: we will celebrate a Rite of Welcome for our students preparing for sacraments.

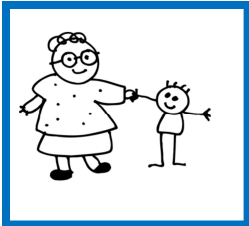

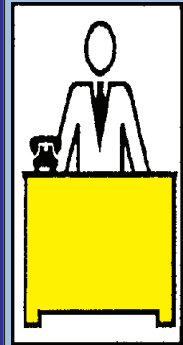
