**LSA Family Health Service**

Founded by the Little Sisters of the Assumption in 1958

**Environmental Health Services** serves children and adults whose asthma symptoms can be improved by mitigating common triggers in the home environment. We do this through hands-on home visits where we provide asthma education, family training, and community workshops led by community health workers specializing in environmental health. A major part of the LSA Family Health Services is part of a class Action Lawsuit, Baez vs NYCHA. Under the Americans with Disabilities Act, NYCHA agreed to fix mold and leaks in a timely manner. What came out of the Lawsuit is the Ombudsman Call Center, where NYCHA residents can call to obtain mold and leak repairs.
