
## FAITH IN THE SECOND HALF OF LIFE

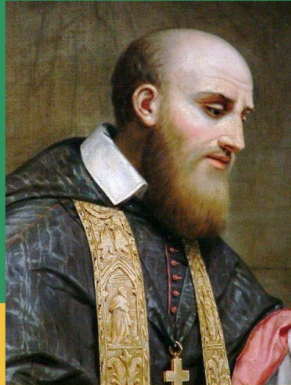
